

This award was established in memory of Meyer and Gita Kron and Ruth Kron Sigal, Lithuanian Jewish survivors of the Holocaust who re-established their lives in Vancouver, British Columbia. Through a life-long involvement with education and community, they affected the lives of thousands of students. Their daughter, Ruth Kron Sigal, survived the Holocaust in hiding and was a dedicated VHEC outreach speaker.

The Kron Sigal Award is presented annually to an elementary or secondary teacher in any discipline who has shown a commitment to teaching students about the Holocaust and its important lessons. The cash award of \$500 will be presented at the **Vancouver Holocaust Education Centre Annual General Meeting** on **June 19, 2019**.

To qualify, nominees must be certified teachers who are actively employed in elementary, secondary or parochial schools in the province of British Columbia. Nomination forms may be obtained from the Vancouver Holocaust Education Centre's website. A letter of support from a colleague or administrator should accompany the nomination form.
